Admission Procedures

Prospective students (includes returning students who were previously enrolled at FGC as a dual enrollment student or someone who has not attended FGC for one year) are required to complete a FGC application for admission, inclusive of the residency affidavit (per Florida Statute 1009.21). Students must provide official transcripts indicative of high school graduation when and if applicable, as well as transcripts from all previously attended institutions of higher learning. All foreign educational transcripts must be evaluated by a National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES) approved foreign credential evaluation and translation service.

A number of Associate in Science and Certificate programs are classified as limited access programs, signifying that they are programs for which a limited numbers of students are admitted each semester or year. Limited access programs typically involve a selection process whereby prospective students submit a separate program application with required documents in addition to the standard application for admission to the college. Applicants interested in enrolling in a limited access program should contact the appropriate program director as early as possible. **Admission to the College does not imply nor guarantee admission into any program with special admission requirements.**

Additionally, admission to the College does not signify that you have met or will meet requirements for professional licensure. If your intended program of study requires professional licensure you are encouraged to obtain information relative to those licensure requirements *prior* to entering the program of study.

NOTE: [Section 1009.286](#), Florida Statutes, establishes an "excess hour" surcharge for a student seeking a baccalaureate degree at a state university. It is critical that students, including those entering Florida colleges, are aware of the potential for additional course fees.

"Excess hours" are defined as hours that go beyond 115% of the hours required for a baccalaureate degree program. For example, if the length of the program is 120 credit hours, the student may be subject to an excess hour surcharge for any credits attempted beyond 138 credit hours (115 x 120%).

All students whose educational plan may include earning a bachelor's degree should make every effort to enroll in and successfully complete those courses that are required for the intended major on their first attempt. Florida college students intending to transfer to a state university should identify a major or "transfer program" early and be advised of admission requirements for that program, including approved common prerequisites. Course withdrawals and/or repeats, as well as enrollment in courses non-essential to the intended major, may contribute to a potential excess hour surcharge.

Residency Appeals Committee:

In accordance with Florida Statutes, Florida Gateway College has established a residency appeals committee to consider student appeals of residency determinations. In cases where the applicant expresses a desire to appeal the Admissions classification, the matter will be referred to the designated residency appeal officer or appropriate appeal committee, in accordance with the institution's official appeal process.

The residency appeal officer or committee will convey to the applicant the final residency determination and the reasons for the determination. The final residency determination will be provided to the student in writing upon request. All residency determinations will be subject to judicial review as "final agency action" in the appropriate District Court of Appeal.



Florida Residency for Tuition Purposes:

INFORMATION FOR RESIDENCE CLASSIFICATION:

A Florida "resident for tuition purposes" is a person who has, or a dependent person whose parent or legal guardian has, established and maintained legal residence in Florida for at least 12 consecutive months immediately prior to the first day of classes of the term for which Florida residency is sought.

To qualify as a Florida resident for tuition purposes you must be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident alien, or legal alien granted indefinite stay by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services(USCIS). Living in or attending school in Florida will not, in itself, establish legal residence. Students who depend on out-of-state parents for support are presumed to be legal residents of the same state as their parents. Residence in Florida must be for the purpose of establishing a permanent home and not merely incident to enrollment at an institution of higher education. Documents supporting the establishment of legal residence must be dated, issued, or filed 12 months before the first day of classes of the term for which a Florida resident classification is sought. The burden of providing clear and convincing documentation that justifies the institution's classification of a student as a resident for tuition purposes rests with the student, or if the student is a dependent, his or her parent.

The [Florida Resident Affidavit](#) must be completed in full if you claim Florida residency for in-state tuition purposes. If you do not qualify as a Florida resident, you must complete the Non-Florida Resident Affidavit. An unsigned affidavit automatically classifies the student as out-of-state for tuition purposes. All supporting documentation must be received to qualify the student under the correct residency status.

INITIAL CLASSIFICATION FOR ALL NEW & RE-ADMITTED STUDENTS:

The Residency Statement (also known as a Residency Affidavit) is to be completed upon admission and/or re-admission to Florida Gateway College to determine residency for tuition purposes. Completion of the Residency Affidavit involves two primary steps which include:

RESIDENCY APPEALS COMMITTEE:

In accordance with Florida Statutes, Florida Gateway College has established a residency appeals committee to consider student appeals of residency determinations. In cases where the applicant expresses a desire to appeal the Admissions classification, the matter will be referred to the designated residency appeal officer or appropriate appeal committee, in accordance with the institution's official appeal process.

The residency appeal officer or committee will convey to the applicant the final residency determination and the reasons for the determination. The final residency determination will be provided to the student in writing upon request. All residency determinations will be subject to judicial review as "final agency action" in the appropriate District Court of Appeal.

- 1) a complete FGC [application for admission](#), inclusive of the residency affidavit (per [Florida Statute 1009.21](#)) and supporting documentation, and;
- 2) official transcripts that verify high school graduation, if applicable for the program of study being declared. This includes home school affidavits and/or a GED® transcript, all of which must include a graduation date. If previously provided student does not need to re-submit.
- 3) official transcripts from any other post-secondary institution that the student may have attended while not enrolled at FGC.

Admission Procedure:

Florida Gateway College has been designated by the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) to offer courses of study to students in the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) with an F-1 visa status. All admission requirements for applying as an international student are detailed in the International Student Application.

Application for Admission – International Students

An F-1 student is a nonimmigrant who is pursuing a “full course of study” to achieve a specific educational or professional objective at an institution in the United States.

To begin the admission process, you will need to print the application and submit it by mail to the admission office along with all the required documents. We will hold your application until we have received your official high school equivalency report and official TOEFL scores.

Please e-mail all questions to the International Student Admissions Specialist at admissions@fgc.edu.

Steps to Obtaining the F-1 VISA

Once Florida Gateway College has received the completed International Application and all the required documents, we will issue you a Form I-20.

The Form I-20 will be mailed to you and is your confirmation that you have been accepted to our institution for a specific program and period of time.

The embassy or consulate will require the Form I-20 when you apply for an F-1 student visa. However, receipt of the Form I-20 does not guarantee you will receive an F-1 student visa.

All international students applying for an F-1 visa will be required to pay a SEVIS fee. For more information regarding this fee and the payment process go to www.ice.gov/sevis/i901/index.htm

If you are already in the United States, you can send the Form I-20 to the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) with a request for change of nonimmigrant status. For more information go to www.uscis.gov.

Port of Entry

As with any international travel, you will need a passport. Make sure your passport is up to date before leaving home. When you arrive at the United States port of entry, the immigration officer will review your passport, the F-1 visa and the Form I-20. If everything is in order, you will be issued a Form I-94.

This card should be kept with your passport, Form I-20 and F-1 visa. It is imperative you have all these documents with you at all times and be prepared to present them to officials if and when asked. All these documents must be given to the Designated School Official at Florida Gateway College upon arrival.
